


English encourages us to use our imagination and sparks creativity!

• Language – Explorations in creative writing and reading.

In Year 11 you will study:

• Language – Writers viewpoints and perspectives and revision for exam paper 1.

• Literature – Macbeth, poetry and revision for exam paper 2.

Throughout the course, students develop and hone their creative and analytical skills.



Whatever your next steps are in life, you will need your English GCSE!




You will sit two end of year exam papers for both English Language and English Literature.

Speaking and listening presentations take place throughout the course and are assessed internally.



- Reading 50%
- Writing 50%

Speaking and listening grade is assessed separately.
