


Plastic surgery was invented during WWI to deal with injuries the soldiers had.

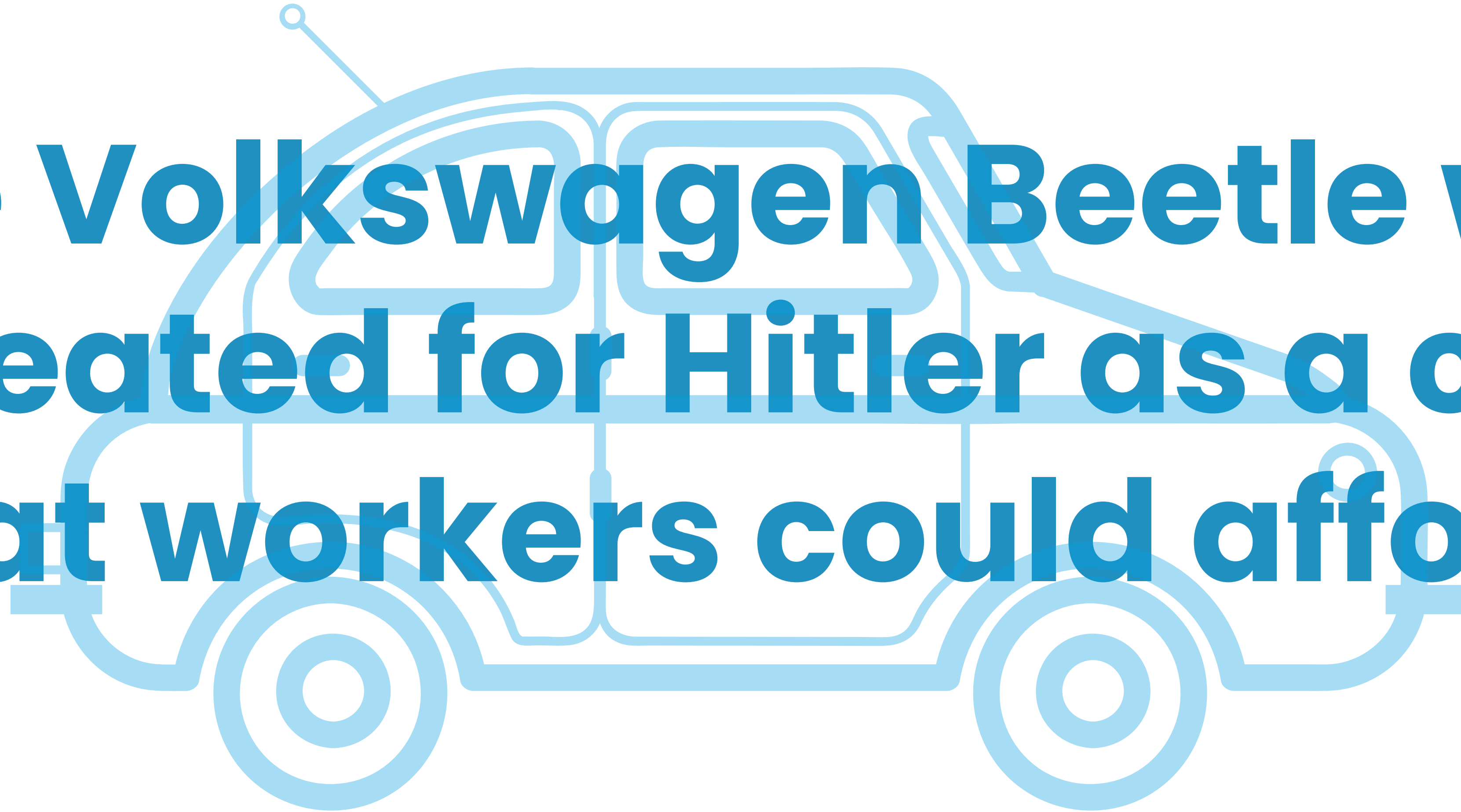


**After WWI, in Germany,

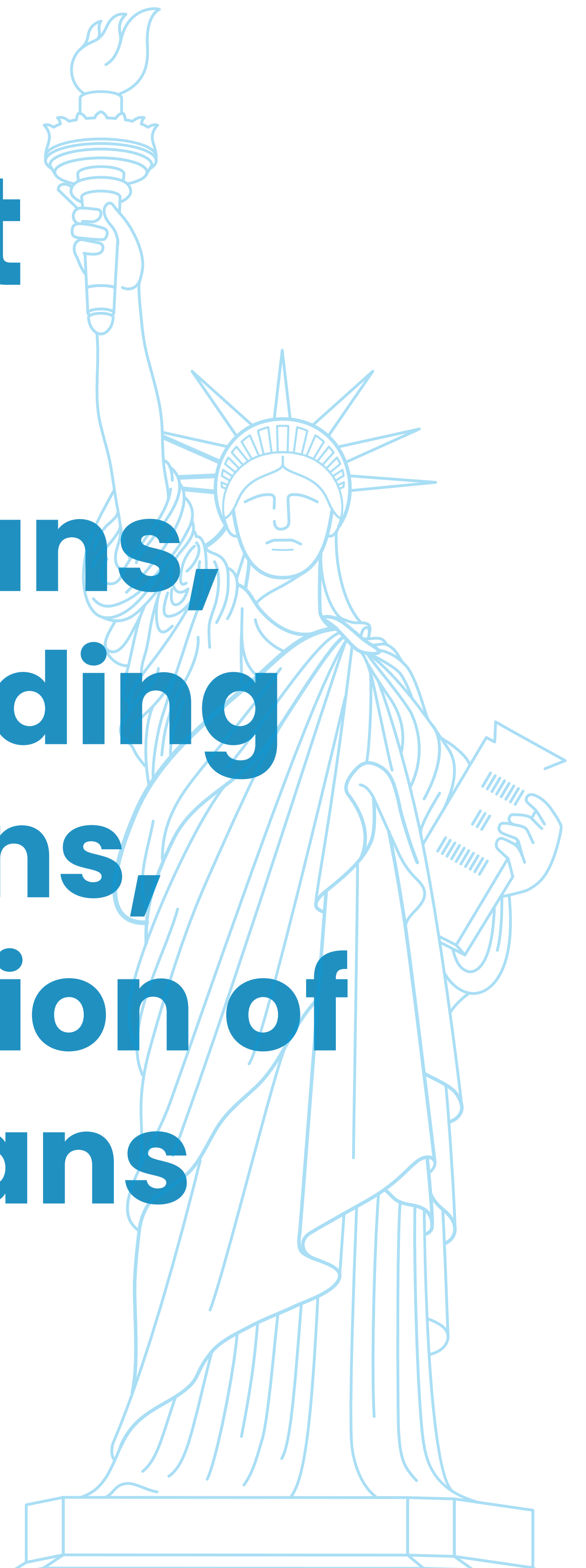

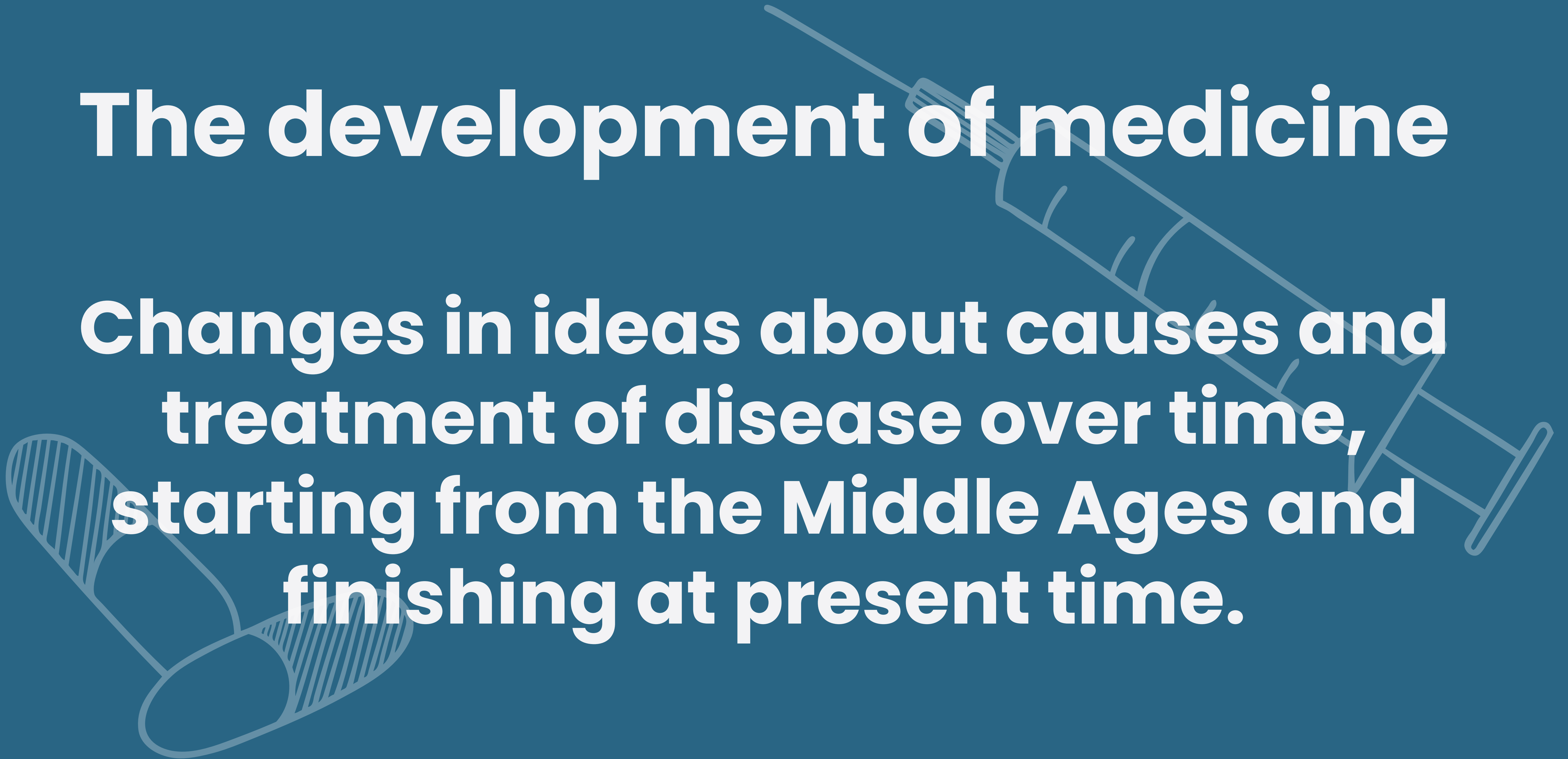

Changes in ideas about causes and treatment of disease over time, starting from the Middle Ages and finishing at present time.





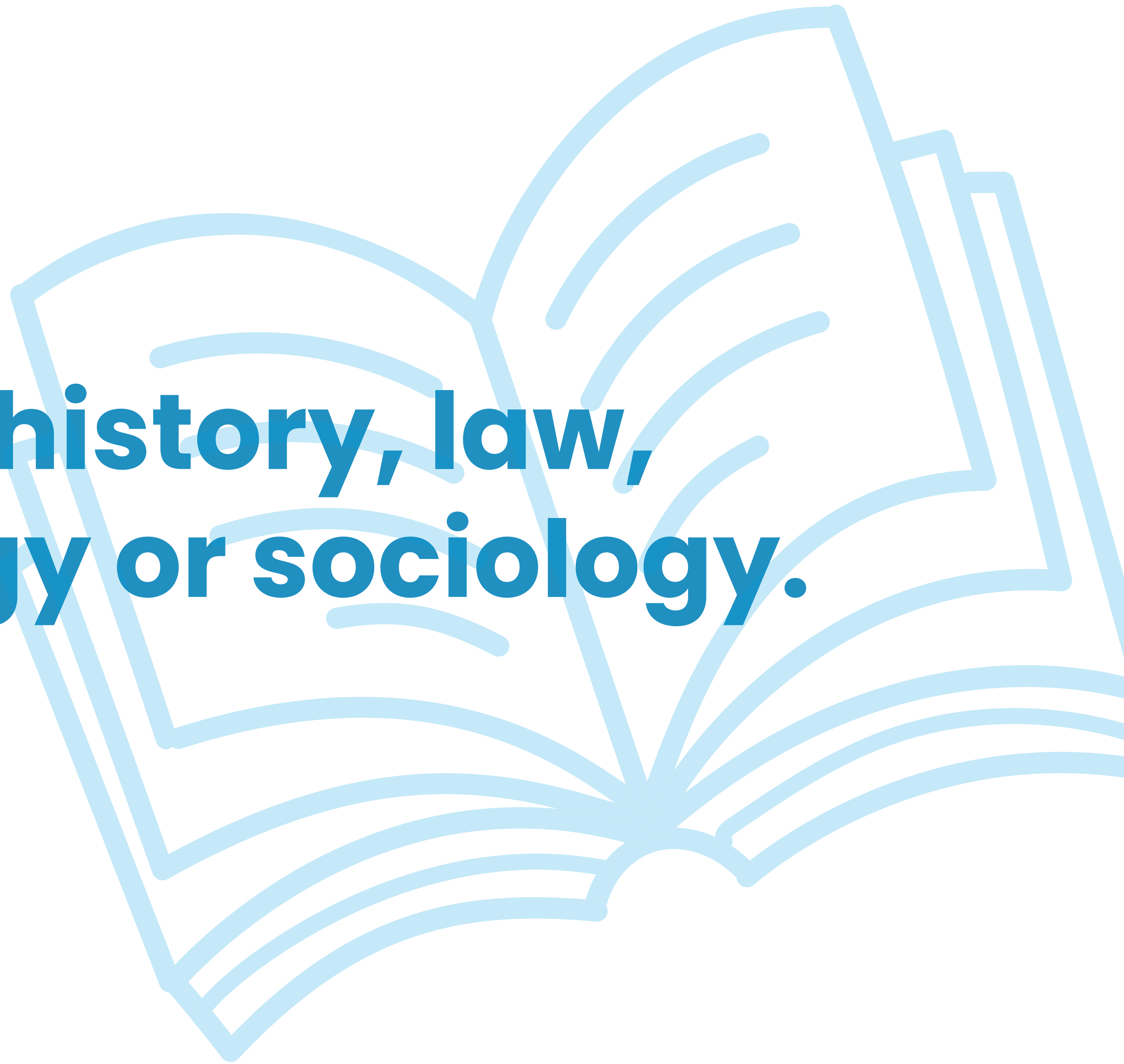
