Reminder that the final deadline for UCAS is **January 31st**. Students can still apply after this time, but they would fall outside the equal consideration date and therefore offers are subject to availability.

We have received information from Newcastle University about the Partner's programme and a change to the deadline date for applications. In previous years the application to Partner's has been open after the UCAS deadline. They have now said that due to the high number of applications they are moving the application deadline forward to the 31st January to be in line with UCAS. If your child wishes to apply for Partner's please ensure they do so by the deadline date.
