For Years 10 and 12, towards the end of the summer term, students will sit a series of formal end of year assessments in the subjects they study. These assessments also ensure our students are fully prepared for future examinations in Years 11 and 13.

In the meantime, and so that students can begin revising, heads of department have been asked to ensure Years 10 and 12 students, no later than Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022, are provided with revision/topic lists so they can plan their time accordingly and appropriately.
