Partial Opening from Monday 23rd March 2020

These are indeed difficult and unprecedented times. As you will be aware, the school will be partially opened to specific groups of pupils as identified by the government.

I would like to provide further information for next week and we will update you as things change or develop.

In terms of students who are coming into school:

- the school will be open for the normal school day, 8:30am 14:50pm;
- students should wear **normal school uniform** for safety and safeguarding reasons;
- students should also bring their full PE kit each day;
- students should arrive through the **main reception**, where a member of staff will greet them and register them;
- the school chef will talk with the students each morning and provide them with a range of options for break and lunch, which will be paid for in the normal way (if a student receives free school meals, this will continue as normal) – students may of course bring packed lunch if they prefer;
- support and teaching staff will be available to support students on the home learning activities they have been set, alongside other pre-planned activities and specialist teaching;
- a member of senior staff will be in school at all times.

The areas of the school where students will be based, will be 'deep cleaned' on a daily basis and, therefore, students will be restricted to specified areas of the site.

Should a parent/carer wish to contact the school for information or in an emergency situation, they should do so via the school office on 0191 388 7161 – this will be manned from 8am until 15:30pm. You will also be able to access the school email account throughout the day, including weekends and evenings: enquiries@hermitageacademy.co.uk.

Finally, we understand that this is a difficult and worrying time, and we aim to keep parents/carers and students updated and informed regularly in relation to what is happening with school.
