# Teaching & learning

**We believe students and their parents/carers have the right to expect a first class education, delivered by teachers who are committed to making learning challenging and rewarding.**

We provide high-quality teaching and, in return, expect a high standard of learning in the classroom. This is evident in the excellent work you will see from our students. Teachers continually strive, through quality professional development and training, to deliver challenging lessons that engage students and drive them towards excellence.

High-quality home learning opportunities are key to students' success. Every student has their own Office 365 account through which they access homework, learning resources and strategies.

Homework underpins how children learn and therefore high-quality homework is set regularly and monitored thoroughly.

Our practice is underpinned by the latest research evidence. Teaching staff employ strategies which help students learn and remember key content and our tracking system ensures that we can quickly

identify students who are struggling to complete work so that appropriate support can be offered.

Careers guidance, promotion and signposting is embedded throughout our curriculum and we are dedicated to preparing students for all of the opportunities a forever developing world has to offer. Through bespoke careers guidance, job exposure, work experience, employer interactions, CV building and interview preparation students leave Hermitage Academy ready for their next steps.

# Support & celebrate

## **Personal, Social, Health and Economic education (PHSE)**

Year managers and form tutors see their students every day with a focus on providing individual support, where every student is well known and cared for. Form tutors are students' first point of contact. As a team, they deliver our PHSE curriculum where all students learn the necessary knowledge and skills to cope with the ever changing, modern world with confidence and resilience.

## **Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) and pastoral support**

Our pastoral staff work extensively with other staff, parents/carers and external agencies to provide exceptional personal support and ensure that students flourish and leave us as well rounded individuals.

Our committed SEND team works diligently to address these needs through strategies such as

in-class targeted support and bespoke support sessions. Their goal is to ensure that every student achieves their best possible progress, both academically and pastorally.

We listen to our students and work hard to build good working partnerships with parents and carers. This way we are able to operate a flexible system of support that breaks down barriers and gives every child the opportunity to succeed.

## **House system and rewards**

Students will join one of four houses within Hermitage Academy: Ambition, Evolution, Integrity, and Synergy. Students belong to their house family and work together to earn praise points for positive behaviour and attitudes resulting in a termly winning house. Rewards include silent discos, pizza evenings, inflatable assault courses and much more. Praise points are earned for displaying our 'RAMP' characteristics: respect, appearance, manners and punctuality.

# Moving up from primary

**Starting a new school is a truly exciting time so we do our utmost to support children (and their parents/carers!) to ensure that their transition from primary school is as smooth as possible.**

Additionally, as a National Teaching School Hub, NELT is one of 87 centres across England offering teachers high quality training and development throughout their careers.

NELT's founding school, The Academy at Shotton Hall, is also a National Research School, one of just 23 in England that up-skill teachers using cutting-edge research.

NELT is led by outstanding educators, including CEO Dame Lesley Powell CBE, who actively contributes to regional and national educational development. It has also built up a wide network of specialist teachers and other experienced professionals to support schools on their paths to becoming outstanding.
